Lucas Sithole's given Zulu name was NCANE meaning "small". As a suburban kid, he disliked that name and called himself TED (Note from Lillian dated 29th Nov. 1955). *This was later changed to Lucas T. SITHOLE, where the "T" stood for "Thandukwazi" which meant "Wouldn't you like to know"!*
